

TEST SCHEDULE

Saturday 7:00 A.M.

Master: Events 01 and 02 will alternate braces with their respective judges.
Senior: Events 01 and 02 will alternate braces with their respective judges.
Junior: Two courses will be used. Events 01 and 02 entries will run on each course.
Entrants will run one event on Course A and one event on Course B.

Sunday 7:00 A.M.

Master: Events 03 and 04 will alternate braces with their respective judges.
Senior: Events 03 and 04 will alternate braces with their respective judges.
Junior: Two courses will be used. Events 03 and 04 entries will run on each course.
Entrants will run one event on Course A and one event on Course B.

Courses: We will be running both events on each day congruently. Rotating braces with a different set of judges. Master and Senior level entrants should be available based on the start time of the events. Braces are not guaranteed to finish, so your specific start time may be affected. This enables us to manage the daylight time and help ensure all entries are able to get their runs. Junior Test Levels will have two courses. The Hunt Test Committee reserves the option to rearrange the running order, judges, braces, start times or add a second field should conditions warrant. Fees are per dog, per day. The bracing schedule will be emailed to entrants after closing.

Running Dogs in Congruent Tests

AKC policy allows dogs to run congruent in all levels. Dogs can now obtain legs/passes in different levels and work on earning titles at the same time. Example: A dog can run in Senior and Master levels in the same event and earn passes that will count toward the required pass total for each level. With regard to the number of passes needed, all other AKC requirements apply.

Advanced Titles

Advanced titles (JHA, SHA, MHA, and MHX). A Pointing Breed Hunting Test Advanced title is awarded when a dog passes five additional times with an average qualifying score of 8.0 or higher after earning its initial title in a test level. Visit the AKC website Performance pages for information.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season may compete, but all AKC rules apply.

Electronic Tracking Collars

Use of Electronic Tracking Collars are not permitted in these tests.

Use of ATVs

Judges will be riding ATVs or walking. No ATVs are allowed in the bird field at any time, per AKC Rules and Regulations.

We do not need you to complete all dog information and a separate piece of paper for each event you enter if the information for the dog is the same. Let's save some trees and reduce the amount of sheets of paper the committee has to deal with.
